Note: Simple camping rules for everyone:

Fire wood: please take your own firewood; alternately firewood is available from the guides at Kubu Island at reasonable cost.

Garbage: All garbage must be removed when you leave Kubu Island, for those travelling north dumps are in either Gweta or Nata, and those travelling South the dump is in Mmatshumo village. Please help keep Kubu Island clean!

Kubu Island is a place of great natural beauty and a Nation Monument, we ask that you respect this by not driving on the Pan, people are only allowed to drive to the camping sites and park on designated parking area. Clients are only allowed to walk to the island. The selfish actions of one or two individuals will degrade the experience for everyone! Anyone found to be disregarding this simple rule, will be fined and ejected from Kubu Island.
